

Proposal for Supplement 13 to UN Regulation No. 65 (Special Warning Lamps)

Submitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling*

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its ninety-second session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/92, para. 27). It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2024/16/Rev.1. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration at their November 2025 sessions.

Paragraph 4.4.1.3., amend to read:

"4.4.1.3. "T", "HT" or "X" according to the category of the unit, followed by "A" or "B" or "R" according to any colour the unit can emit (see paragraph 2.1. above)."

Paragraph 5.1., for "paragraph 5.1.1.5. in UN Regulation No. 100" read "paragraph 5.1.1.4. in UN Regulation No. 100".

Paragraph 5.8., amend to read:

"5.8. A special warning lamp device of Category T, HT or X may be approved for the colours blue, amber and red separately. In this case, the activation of more than one colour at the same time shall be prohibited.

The lamp manufacturer shall supply mounting information, for correct mounting on a vehicle, to ensure that only one colour of the special warning lamp is activated at the same time."

Paragraph 5.9., amend to read:

"5.9. In the case of special warning lamps approved under this Regulation, it shall be not possible for the user to activate groups of several flashes (flash patterns), which do not conform to the requirements in paragraph 6 of this Regulation."
